



POSITIVE CASE GUIDELINES

NOTIFY CAMP@BYDS.ORG OF POSITIVE CAMPER CASES

STAFF / PRE-K - 5TH GRADE CAMPERS REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

1. Stay home for 5 days
2. If you have no symptoms after 5 days, you can return to campus
3. Wear a mask while indoors around others for 5 additional days

INFANTS - THREES CAMPERS

1. Stay home for 10 days total off campus
2. Camper may return to campus symptom-free after 10 days

ON-CAMPUS EXPOSURE PROTOCOLS

CAMP BYDS STAFF WILL SEND AN EXPOSURE NOTIFICATION EMAIL

Option 1 Test on day of notification AND test again on Day 5 of exposure

Option 2 Quarantine off campus and Test on or after Day 5 of exposure

Option 3 Quarantine for 10 days and return on Day 11 without a test if asymptomatic

IF CAMPER DEVELOPS SYMPTOMS, STAY HOME AND FOLLOW OUR SICK POLICY

HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE PROTOCOLS

NOTIFY CAMP@BYDS.ORG OF HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURES

FOR VACCINATED CAMP AND STAFF

1. Wear a mask while indoors around others for 10 days and test on Day 5 after exposure
2. If camper develops symptoms, stay home and follow our sick policy

FOR UNVACCINATED STUDENTS AND STAFF

1. Stay home for 5 days and test on Day 5 after exposure
2. Return to campus on Day 6 and wear a mask while indoors around others for 5 additional days
3. If camper develops symptoms, stay home and follow our sick policy

An exposed person does not need to test or quarantine if they have a confirmed COVID-19 positive test within the past 90 days.

UPDATED SICK POLICY

Regardless of vaccination status, anyone with a fever or symptoms must leave school. Parents will be notified and must pick up their child within an hour of receiving a call. Camp BYDS Staff will remain with the student until pick up.

Keep your child at home if they exhibit the following symptoms: Fever (greater than 100 degrees) • vomiting • diarrhea • chills • severe stomach ache • severe sore throat (consider taking your child for testing) • general malaise or feelings of fatigue • discomfort • weakness • muscle aches • frequent congested (wet) or croupy cough • lots of nasal congestion with frequent blowing of the nose

Your child may return to school only after their temperature is below 100 degrees for a minimum of 24 hours without the aid of medication, symptoms have desisted, or with a doctor's clearance.
